Varieties:	Pinot Noir
Region:	Tumbarumba NSW
Winemaking notes:	Cold soaked with regular daily pump-overs to aerate the wine. Matured in French oak barriques.
Awards:	2018 – just released!
Tasting notes	
Colour:	Light vibrant cherry red in colour.
Nose:	Lifted and fragrant nose of cherries, herbs and spice.
Palate:	Bright, light and lifted palate dominated by raspberries and cherries and layered with earth and spice. A youthful pinot with subtle complexities appearing on the long, silky finish.
Comments:	The Coppabella Vineyard is located in Tumbarumba, the coldest viticultural region in mainland Australia. It has an array of soil types, aspects, and clones.
