





Coppabella of Tumbarumba Pinot Gris 2021

Variety:	Pinot Gris
Region:	Tumbarumba NSW
Winemaking notes:	From a single block on the Coppabella vineyard at approximately 650m above sea level. The fruit was night harvested, gently pressed then fermented cool in stainless steel tanks to retain freshness and brightness.
TASTING NOTES	
Colour:	Brilliant pale straw
Nose:	Lifted notes of apricot, nashi pear and citrus.
Palate:	The apricot and nashi pear follow through on the palate alongside white flowers, lemon and subtle spice. Beautifully layered with a concentrated palate delivering a zesty and lingering textural mouthfeel.
Comments:	Sourced from a high altitude site in the cool Tumbarumba region of NSW; one of the most significant emerging regions in Australia that's perfectly suited to this variety. This wine celebrates its regionality and demonstrates Tumbarumba's potential as one of Australia's key regions for Pinot Gris.
