





Coppabella of Tumbarumba The Crest Pinot Noir 2021

Varieties:	Pinot Noir
Region:	Tumbarumba NSW
Winemaking notes:	A blend of three great Pinot Noir clones: 777, MV6 and D5V12, sourced from varying elevations and aspects on the vineyard. The fruit was hand picked and a portion was fermented on indigenous yeast with some whole bunches included in the ferment. Matured for 12 months in French Barriques.
Tasting notes	
Colour:	Ruby red with a garnet hue
Nose:	A delightfully bright and expressive nose of strawberry and rhubarb.
Palate:	A core of sweet, soft and juicy red fruit, coated in spices and tethered to ripe tannins. It's not big, but it feels rich and velvety.
Comments:	The closest climate parallels to Tumbarumba in the Southern Hemisphere are Central Otago and Tasmania; two of the great emerging new world regions for this style. It's little surprise then that great Pinot can also be made in Tumbarumba.
Alcohol:	13.5%
