



Coppabella of Tumbarumba



Sirius Pinot Noir 2021 Varieties: Pinot Noir Region: Tumbarumba NSW A blend of three great Pinot Noir clones: 777, Winemaking notes: MV6 and D5V12, sourced from varying elevations and aspects on the vineyard. The fruit was hand picked from our T21 block and a portion was fermented on indigenous yeast with some whole bunches included in the ferment. Matured for 12 months in French Barriques. Tasting notes Colour: Ruby red with a garnet hue Nose: Earth and wild-flower aromas are underscored by sweet cherries, red berries and spice. Palate: Silky in texture, with cherry, strawberry and subtle gamey notes unfolding in the glass. The flavours are delicate yet vibrant. The acidity and polished tannins providing structure. Comments: The closest climate parallels to Tumbarumba in the Southern Hemisphere are Central Otago and Tasmania; two of the great emerging new world regions for this style. It's little surprise then that

great Pinot can also be made in Tumbarumba.
