Coppabella of Tumbarumba The Sirius Chardonnay 2021

Varieties:	Chardonnay
Region:	Tumbarumba NSW
Viticulture:	The grapes are sourced from our prized Block T20, planted at 650m to V1 clone in 1993.
Vintage:	Near perfect ripening conditions were punctuated by significant rain events in January and February but with diligent canopy management and disease control we were able to produce excellent quality fruit.
Winemaking:	Chilled grapes are whole bunch pressed straight to barrel for fermentation. The solids are kept with the free run juice for added complexity.
Awards:	96pts – Sam Kim, Wine Orbit 94pts – Erin Larkin, Wine Advocate 4 x GOLD Medals
Tasting notes	
Colour:	Pale straw with green flecks
Nose:	A bright clean nose of apple, stone fruits and subtle almond notes.
Palate:	A luxurious palate that has perfect tension thanks to a core of high natural acid. The palate unfolds with crushed nuts, roasted pineapple, red apple skins and nougat.
Comments:	Sirius is Coppabella’s flagship wine. Grown in the foothills of the Snowy Mountains; climatically, Tumbarumba shares more parallels with Burgundy than other Australian wine regions.
